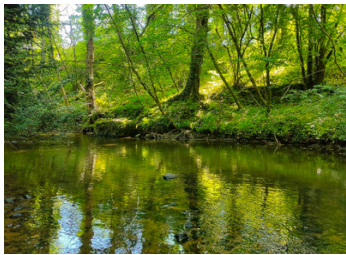


Imposing bed and breakfast in the heart of a thriving village with a hectare of land and river frontage

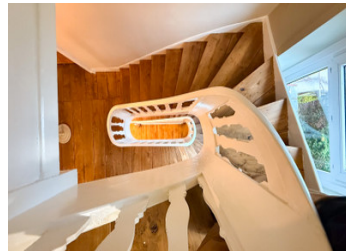

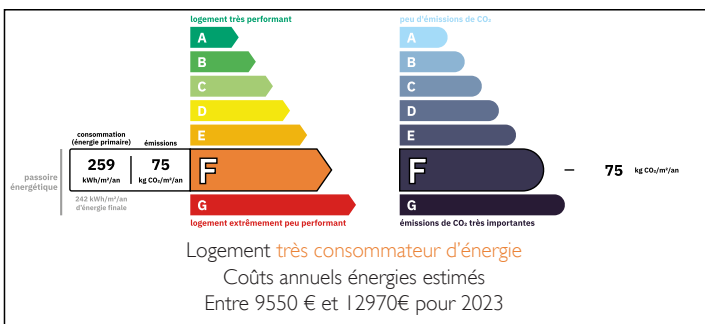
IN BRIEF

This lovely, historic house is currently run as a successful three bedroom bed and breakfast business but also has a top floor two bedroom owner's apartment. There is scope to develop the business to increase letting rooms or to create an additional apartment.

The garden (around a hectare) is a rare find in the centre of a thriving village with the added bonus of river frontage running through your own woodland - a magical place.

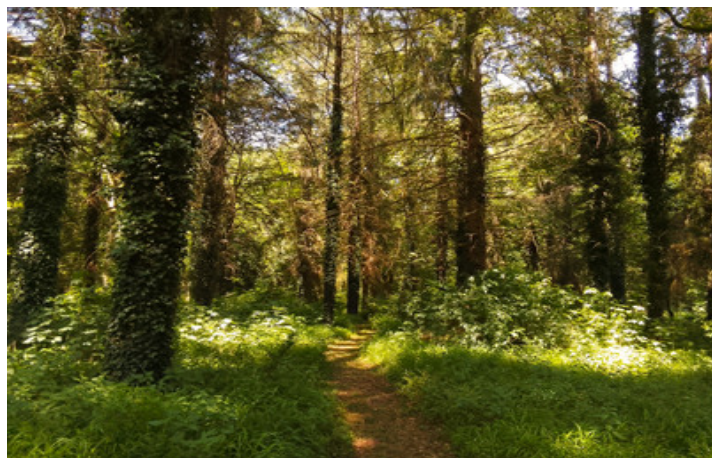

DESCRIPTION

This property sits in the heart of this pretty village - quiet but still close to all facilities and a 50 metre walk to a well known local restaurant.

Downstairs is the bar area (also used as breakfast area for the B&B guests) behind this is a well equipped kitchen and office. On the other side of the hallway is one of the B&B rooms, a family suite, with living area, bedroom area and separate bed area for children. Accommodation on this floor is completed by a downstairs bathroom.

Upstairs are two delightful ensuite B&B rooms, both with ensuite showers. On the other side of the house is an area of multiple rooms for development that could be additional letting rooms or a separate two bedroom apartment for habitation or for rental. Upstairs again there is two bedroom apartment currently used as living quarters by the owners. Open plan living / dining / kitchen area and two bedrooms plus a huge bathroom with large bath and walk in shower.

Outside to the rear of the house, stone steps sweep down to a large garden, around half of which (over an acre) is laid to lawn with around half a hectare of beautiful woodland leading down to the river Gorre. This is a lovely and rare find and at a very competitive price - viewing is highly recommended.
