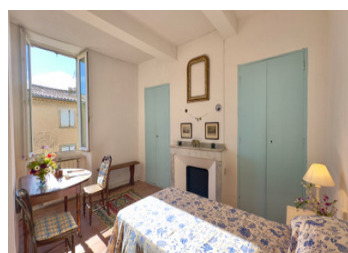

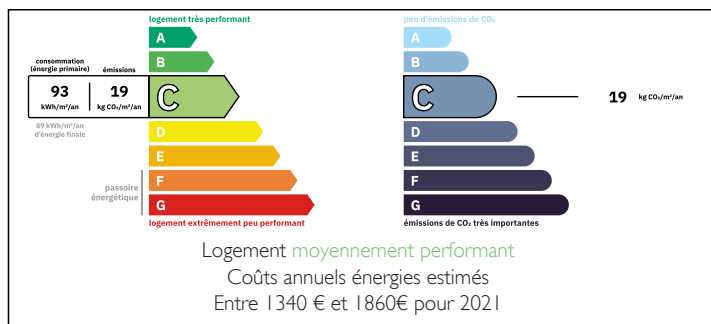

DESCRIPTION

Saint-Vallière offers an exceptional combination of history, comfort, and the classic South-of-France aesthetic. Its exterior features a fully revealed stone façade with traditional wooden shutters—exactly the style many buyers envision when dreaming of a French village home.

Built into the original medieval village walls, the property carries centuries of history, possibly close to a thousand years. Over the past two decades, the current owners have lovingly restored and modernised the house, preserving its soul while creating a practical and energy-efficient home. The exceptionally thick stone walls provide natural insulation, ensuring cool interiors during hot summers and warmth in winter.

The house spans four bright levels, accessed via a traditional tomettes-and-wood staircase. On the lower ground floor, the spacious, light-filled kitchen forms the heart of the home. It easily accommodates a dining table and opens directly onto a charming terrace, ideal for alfresco meals. A stone-lined storage room behind the kitchen, echoing the building's ancient origins, provides the perfect space for wine storage.

The upper ground floor is accessed through a delightful village alleyway with a stone arch. Here a welcoming entrance hall leads to the dining room, once the old kitchen and still featuring a beautiful antique stone sink. The adjoining living room has a fireplace and abundant natural light. A bright WC with washbasin completes this level.

On the first floor, two spacious, light-filled bedrooms are complemented by a large, sunlit bathroom with both a bath and a shower. On the top floor, there is another generous...
