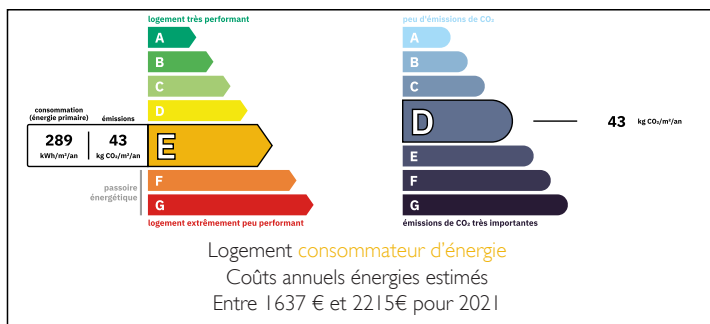

The sleeping area includes two comfortable bedrooms, a study area, and 2 shower rooms /WC.

The house offers 3 well-laid-out rooms over approximately 100 m², blending the charm of exposed beams and stone with the comfort of central heating and double glazing.

The night area is well laid out and offers two comfortable bedrooms, ideal for family living or hosting guests. A shower room with WC serves this part of the house, while a second bathroom with WC and a dedicated laundry area provides additional comfort and convenience for daily life.
