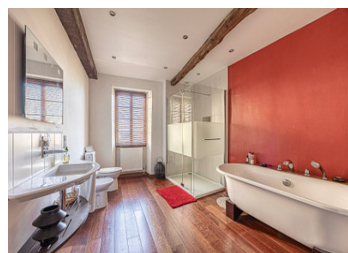


## Superb 5 bedroom Maison de Maître with 3-Bed Gîte, Barn & Pool near Gaillac and Toulouse

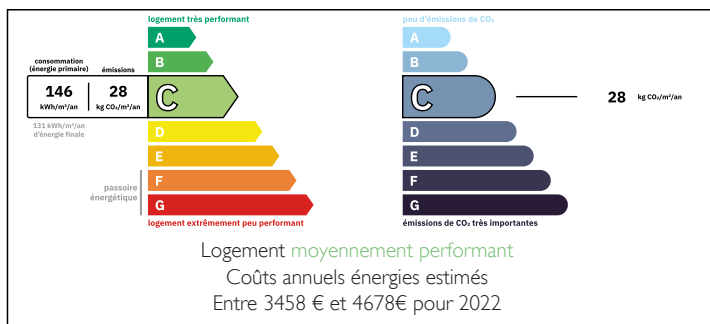
## IN BRIEF

Light floods the expansive reception rooms, creating exceptional volumes and an atmosphere of refined country elegance.

With 5 bedrooms, stunning living areas, a wonderful kitchen, a large convertible attic, salt swimming pool and multiple terraces, this is far more than a beautiful home — it is a truly special property,

## DESCRIPTION

This elegant MAISON DE MAÎTRE, dating from circa 1800, immediately impresses with its architectural balance, blue shutters and refined proportions. Renovated to a high standard, it combines historic character with modern comfort, offering light-filled interiors and exceptional volumes throughout.

### MAIN HOUSE GROUND FLOOR

A wide and welcoming ENTRANCE HALL sets the tone, leading to beautifully proportioned reception spaces.

The magnificent KITCHEN (39m<sup>2</sup>) is truly the heart of the home — fully equipped and thoughtfully designed, with doors opening directly onto the terrace. A huge original fireplace with woodburner, beautiful tiled flooring and generous workspace create both warmth and practicality.

The SALON (30m<sup>2</sup>) features original tomettes and two sets of double doors overlooking the garden, terraces and pool area — a bright and elegant living space.

A wide hallway leads to the impressive BUANDERIE (23m<sup>2</sup>), offering excellent storage and utility space, plus a separate WC with hand basin.

A step up reveals the spectacular LIVING / DINING ROOM (55m<sup>2</sup>). This breathtaking room, with exposed beams, travertine flooring and a large open fireplace in use, is flooded with natural light from windows on two elevations. A true “wow factor” space, ideal for entertaining on a grand scale.

A beautiful staircase rises to the first floor.

### FIRST FLOOR

BEDROOM I (40m<sup>2</sup>) is flooded with light from tall windows, with high ceilings and lovely views.
