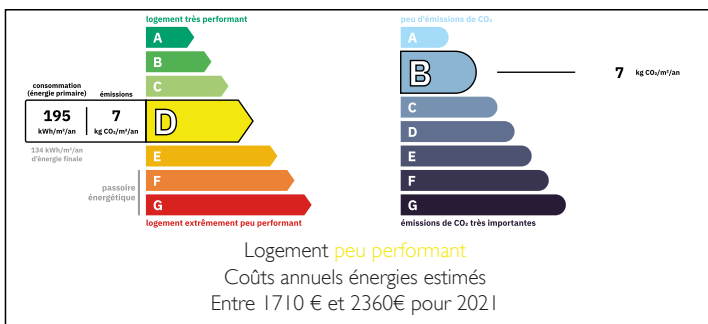

DESCRIPTION

As you approach the property down the quiet lane serving just the three houses, there is an area opposite the house for parking.

On entering the property there is a small hallway with WC, coat and boots area plus stairs to the first floor.

The hall opens into the kitchen which is open plan to the large lounge. The room is flooded with natural light. In one corner the vendors have a dining table and in another corner there is a large storage cupboard plus what used to be a bar but now works as an office space. The property has tiled floors throughout and feature stone wall where the traditional wood burner sits. From the kitchen there are steps down to a shower room and laundry area.

On the first floor there is a large landing with two bedrooms and a generous size bathroom with shower cubicle and WC. The large of the two rooms has access through the window to a roof terrace which could be railed to be made usable.

A sturdy wooden staircase leads to the top floor which is a full size, floored attic with exposed beams. Perfect for another bedroom or a playroom/craft room.

Outside there is a decked area plus a paved terrace. The current owners covered the grass for easy maintenance and planted numerous colourful shrubs but the garden could be restored to grass. It is such a peaceful spot with beautiful views...
