IN BRIEF

Chalais, in the south of the Charente region, is a small but dynamic town offering shops, a market, and a SNCF train station. It is ideally located between Angoulême and Bordeaux, at the crossroads of four departments: Charente, Charente-Maritime, Dordogne, and Gironde.

Nestled in the heart of the town, this charming period property is arranged around an inner courtyard. Fully renovated with taste in a contemporary style while preserving its original character, the townhouse offers on the ground floor an entrance hall, an office, an elegant living room with fireplace, a bright dining room, and a kitchen.

On the first floor, there are 4 bedrooms, each with its own shower room and WC, and on the second floor, 2 apartments.

DESCRIPTION

Nestled in the heart of Chalais, in the Charente region, this remarkable 18th-century residence elegantly combines period charm with contemporary comfort. Set in a rolling landscape on the edge of the Dordogne, Gironde, and Charente-Maritime regions, the property enjoys a privileged location for making the most of South-West France.

Fully and carefully restored, this bourgeois house has retained all its authenticity: generous volumes, period character, and a warm atmosphere blend harmoniously throughout.

The property offers beautiful living spaces including, on the ground floor, an entrance hall, an office, a living room with fireplace, a dining room, and a kitchen suitable for breakfast service. The first floor hosts four individual suites. On the second floor, two independent apartments each feature an open-plan kitchen and living area, a bedroom, and a shower room with WC.

Outside, a charming landscaped inner courtyard leads to the stone house located opposite. This traditional building, with exposed stonework and beams, has been carefully converted into a large gîte, ideal for hosting family, friends, or for tourist accommodation.

Behind the gîte, a pleasant sunny terrace offers an inviting space to enjoy the outdoors in a peaceful and intimate setting. Above it, a charming hanging garden provides a privileged view over the famous Talleyrand Castle, giving the property a unique atmosphere full of history and character.

At street level, a commercial unit of approximately 82 m², currently available for rent, and a second unit facing the inner courtyard complete this versatile property with multiple possibilities.
