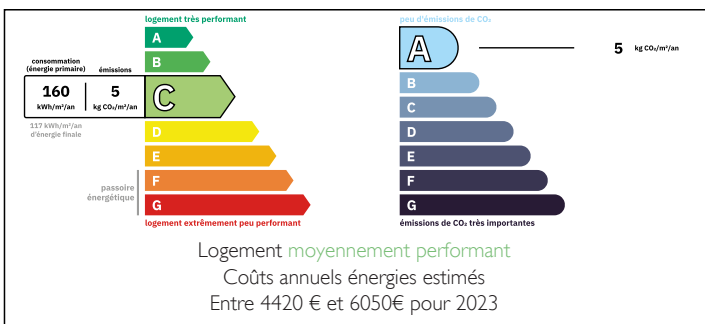
This home offers contemporary style and thoughtful comfort. Every space has been created to make the most of natural light, with wide openings that blur the line between inside and outside.

The bright, spacious rooms invite family life and entertaining alike. On the ground floor, a bedroom and bathroom add everyday practicality.

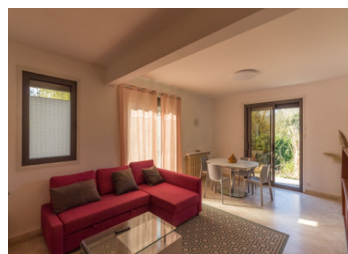

Nonancourt (27320) lies in the Eure department of Normandy, near the border with Eure-et-Loir. The town enjoys a calm setting along the Avre River and has a traditional Norman character, with historic streets and a local train station providing connections toward Dreux and Paris. The surrounding countryside offers green landscapes and rural tranquility.
