The property comprises a habitable stone farmhouse awaiting renovation, together with beautiful stone stables, barns and a range of outbuildings, formerly part of a riding school. Set within almost 50 hectares of farmland, pasture and woodland, the estate is perfectly suited to an elegant private residence, equestrian domain or prestigious rural retreat.

DESCRIPTION

In the unspoilt heart of the Tarn countryside, just moments from the picturesque village of Montredon-Labessonnié, this estate offers a rare balance of privacy, scale and proximity. Set in a secluded position with no immediate neighbours, it enjoys complete tranquillity while remaining within walking distance of village life, including shops, cafés, bars and a traditional bakery.

At the centre of the property stands an authentic stone farmhouse, currently habitable and ready to be reimagined. The existing volumes, period elements and straightforward layout provide a strong foundation for a considered renovation.

The ground floor centres around a generous 80 m² living room, with a central fireplace subtly dividing the space. Exposed beams and stone flooring add depth and character throughout. Double doors open onto a terrace running the full length of the façade, extending the living space outdoors.

Upstairs, five well-proportioned bedrooms form the main accommodation and lead through to an impressive 120 m² timber-framed barn, whose scale offers clear scope for further development.

Above, the attic extends to over 80 m², with sufficient ceiling height to be put to meaningful use. While not currently classified as habitable space, it represents a valuable reserve for future conversion.

Formerly operated as a riding school, the property also includes substantial stone-built stables, along with a collection of barns and outbuildings totalling approximately 400 m². Arranged around the main house, they form a cohesive whole suited to equestrian use, agriculture, workshops or, subject to the necessary permissions, a hospitality or accommodation project.
