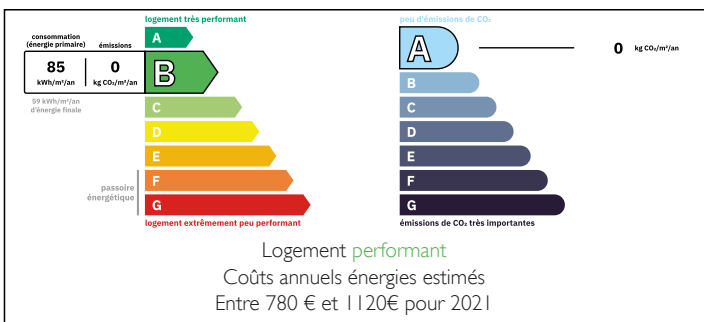


IN BRIEF

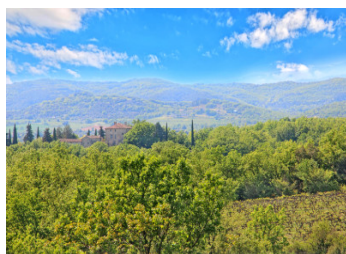

DESCRIPTION

The natural stone house combines character with comfort and benefits from an excellent energy rating. The covered terrace is a wonderful place to enjoy the panoramic views throughout the seasons.

On the ground floor, you will find a bright living area with an open kitchen, a lounge, a toilet with washbasin, and a former garage currently used as additional living space. There is also an utility room with direct access to the terrace.

Upstairs, there are three bedrooms (8 m², 8 m², and 11 m² measured above 1.80 m height, with total floor areas of 12 m², 12 m², and 15 m²), a bathroom with toilet, and practical storage space.

The swimming pool, surrounded by a wooden terrace, is set slightly away from the house and offers a peaceful retreat where you can relax in complete privacy while enjoying the panoramic views.

Further on the property, you will find the former cheese dairy, consisting of several rooms and a loft. This building offers numerous possibilities and can be adapted entirely to your needs. A large covered area is attached.

This estate is also ideal for horse lovers, with plenty of space to create stables and covered parking for a trailer.
