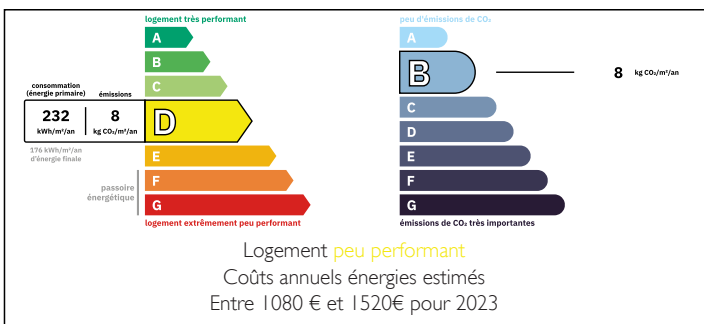


Charming rural property with 2-beds and outstanding potential – Vicq-sur-Nahon, Loire Valley
