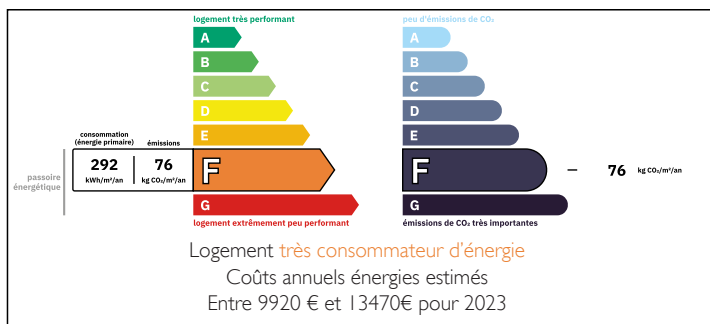


Charming 6-bedroom home with salt pool, 1st floor balcony, super open country views and gîte or B&B potential

From the kitchen, a staircase leads to an impressive living room of approximately 90 m². Flooded with natural light from large windows, this space is enhanced by high ceilings, exposed beams and a striking fireplace.
