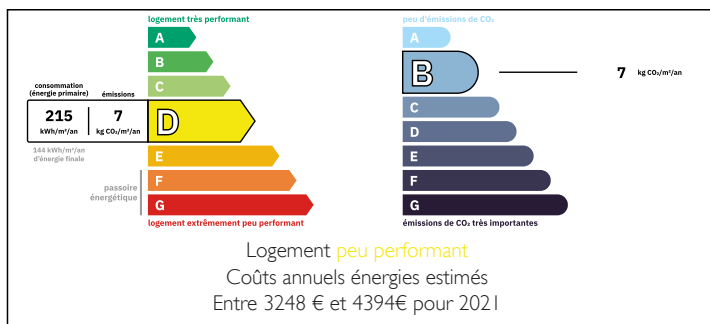

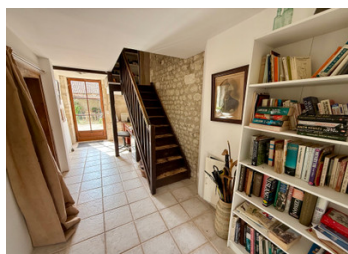

A second bedroom has plumbing in place for a potential ensuite, alongside a separate bath/shower room. The ground floor offers a laundry room with shower and WC, a galley kitchen, generous dining room, and a large sitting room with wood-burning stove, plus an additional area ideal for a study. Dating back around 300 years, the property retains character with two staircases. Outside, there is a courtyard garden, substantial barns, a wine cellar, and a further plot...
