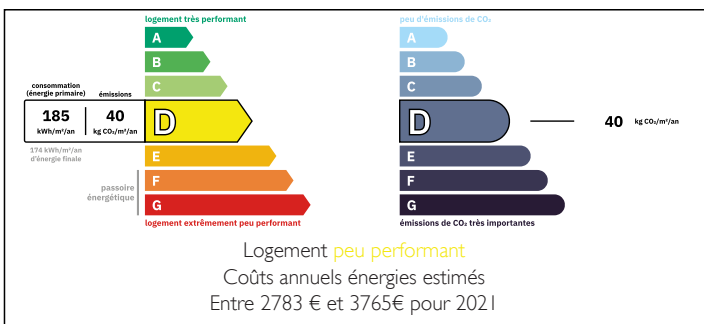

DESCRIPTION

The main residence, which forms the historic heart of the property, has been carefully restored and retains an impressive number of original features. The period terracotta floors, the elegant herringbone oak parquet, and the imposing stone fireplaces all contribute to the property's rich heritage and architectural authenticity.

Upon entering, a generous entrance hall which leads to a beautifully appointed ground-floor bedroom featuring a remarkable original 16th-century lavoir, a rare and evocative piece of the property's history. This level is further complemented by a bathroom with bath, shower, and WC and a utility room.

The first floor reveals the principal living spaces, where charm and comfort blend seamlessly. A welcoming kitchen and dining area, complete with a wood-burning stove, offers a warm and convivial setting. The spectacular main living room is a true centrepiece, boasting a monumental stone fireplace and elegant herringbone oak flooring, exuding both scale and sophistication.

This level also hosts a spacious master bedroom with en-suite shower room, as well as a second bedroom positioned on the opposite side of the living area, ensuring privacy and balance within the layout.

Within the central courtyard to one side of the main house, a charming terrace area provides an ideal setting for outdoor living and entertaining, complete with a summer kitchen. Adjacent to this is the boiler room and a storage room.
