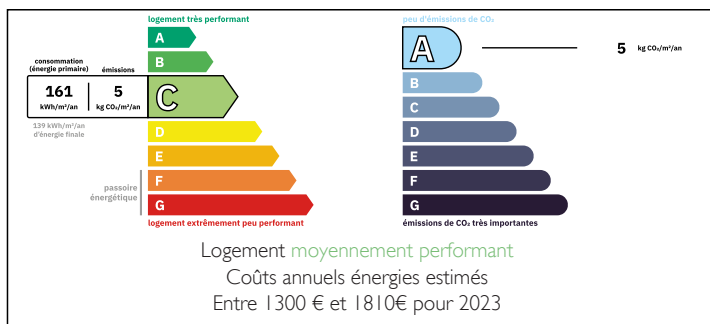

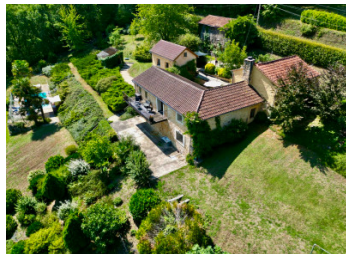

DESCRIPTION

The main house, which was originally a cottage and two barns has been completely restored. It comprises on the ground floor an entrance with a small lounge (approx. 16.30m²) with a Jotul wood stove that heats the whole house thanks to the double-glazed windows and excellent insulation. A wooden staircase leads to the master bedroom (approx. 27.60m²) with its exposed beams. An en-suite shower and toilet (approx. 4.60m²), a dressing area with large built-in wardrobes.. Steps leads from the lounge to the well-equipped country style kitchen (approx. 14m²) with oak kitchen units and worktops, solid oak flooring and exposed beams. The large living room (approx. 43.25m²) with exposed beams, feature stone wall and solid oak flooring enjoys a beautiful brightness and allows access to a balcony with magnificent views of the surrounding countryside. Private access to the basement studio of about 50m² offers flexible accommodation with tiled floors and large glass doors which is currently used as a living room, large bedroom and a bathroom, with bath and fully tiled walk-in shower with its electric heating and double glazing. An existing and protected well in the bathroom is a nice and original feature. The accommodation could equally be used as a family suite of two large bedrooms and a bathroom. On the ground floor there is a laundry/store/games room (approx. 18.70m²). The cottage (approx. 25m²) includes a well-equipped kitchen and living room, a bedroom and en-suite shower with toilet and is in excellent condition. Outside there is a barn (approx....
