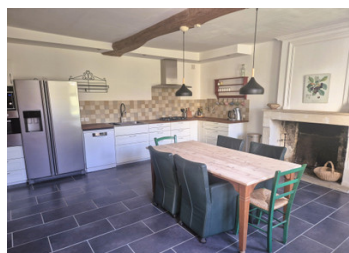


Impressive Manor house with seven gites ideal for weddings and other functions close to St Jean D'Angley.

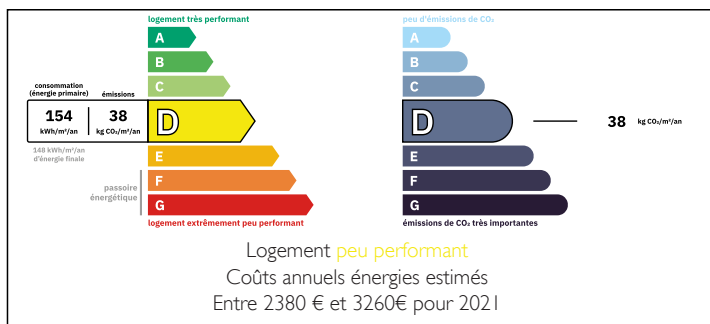


IN BRIEF

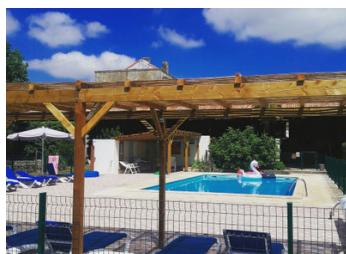

DESCRIPTION

Entering the manor house via the double set of stairs, drenched in history, you walk into the hallway leading into the large function/reception hall with original flooring and a beautiful fireplace. An original wooden staircase leads up to 4 spacious and airy bedrooms, three of which are en-suite and the fourth has a bathroom but separate, as well as an original chapel with stain glass windows dating back to the 17th century. Downstairs there is a large vaulted cellar with paved floor currently being used as a gym.

From the hallway there is another staircase leading to a split-level 2 bedroom apartment, complete with a fully equipped kitchen/dining room, sitting room and two bathrooms.

Attached to the manor house are five gites that have been tastefully restored, each of which boast character and offer lots original features. Each gite has a fully-equipped kitchen, ample living space, good sized bedrooms and bathrooms and look out over the central courtyard.

On the other side of the courtyard is a huge open barn overlooking the garden and courtyard. An ideal venue for summer functions and weddings. To the back of this barn there are two more, well equipped gites, both of which open out onto the well maintained park landscaped with trees, the large swimming pool area and the large open garden area. There are further buildings, currently used for storage but offers good potential for additional accommodation. Within the courtyard area there is a...
