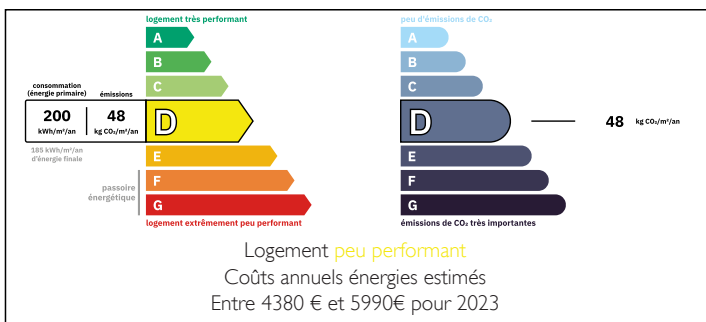

DESCRIPTION

The property comprises an entrance hall with stairs leading to the upper floors.

The heart of the home is an exceptionally large kitchen-dining room featuring a wood-burning stove. The kitchen offers a unique and quirky layout, positioned centrally within one half of the room, creating a distinctive living space. Doors from the kitchen open directly onto the expansive wraparound terrace, perfect for outdoor dining and entertaining.

Also on the ground floor is another substantial reception room, flooded with natural light through bespoke floor-to-mezzanine-height glazed doors and windows. These provide spectacular views towards the rear of the property, with the picturesque church of Gargillesse perched on the hilltop beyond. Off this room are a laundry area and a large shower room with WC.

On the first floor, a spacious mezzanine area enjoys breathtaking views through the full-height windows and is currently used as a home office. This level also offers three generous double bedrooms and a family shower room with WC.

The second floor provides two further exceptionally large bedrooms, offering flexible accommodation for family or guests.

Beneath the house is a cave/boiler room providing useful storage and utility space.

Outside, the property benefits from a large private garden, mainly laid to lawn, and features not one but two traditional pigeon towers (pigeonniers), adding to its character and charm.
