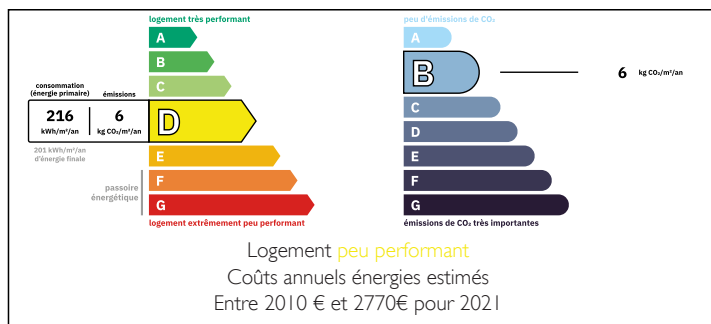

The house offers warm and bright living spaces, including a spacious living room with mezzanine of approximately 42 m², a 14.9 m² kitchen, a 21 m² lounge, as well as several additional rooms of 20 m² and 11.2 m². Upstairs are two bedrooms (20 m² and 22 m²), a 36 m² mezzanine and two shower rooms.

DESCRIPTION

At the heart of the Périgord-Limousin Regional Natural Park, in the preserved commune of Busserolles in the Dordogne department (24), this character property enjoys an exceptional and particularly rare natural environment. Nestled within rolling countryside surrounded by forests, meadows and rivers, the estate will appeal to lovers of peace, authenticity and unspoiled nature.

The Périgord Vert region is renowned for the beauty of its landscapes, its historical heritage and its quality of life. The area offers charming stone villages, traditional markets, castles, hiking trails and omnipresent nature ideal for outdoor activities such as walking, horse riding, fishing, canoeing or simply enjoying the scenery.

The Dronne River, particularly appreciated for its purity and wild landscapes, flows through this remarkably preserved region.

Despite its peaceful and secluded atmosphere, the property remains easily accessible:

- * Angoulême and its TGV train station with connections to Paris and Bordeaux: approximately 55 minutes
- * Nontron: approximately 20 minutes
- * Brantôme, known as the "Venice of the Périgord": approximately 35 minutes
- * Limoges International Airport: approximately 1 hour
- * Bordeaux: approximately 2 hours

The property offers a rare combination of privacy, vast natural surroundings and environmental quality. With no close neighbours, it would perfectly suit a main residence, holiday home, tourism project, countryside retreat or an autonomous lifestyle project in harmony with nature.
