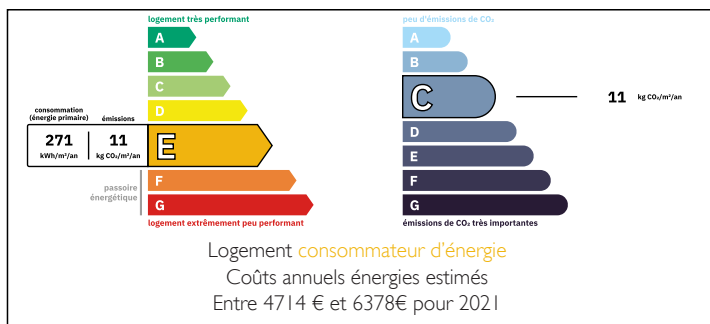

Transport links are excellent, with Poitiers airport 40 km away, Limoges 82 km, the Channel ports around 400 km, and the Poitiers-Paris...
