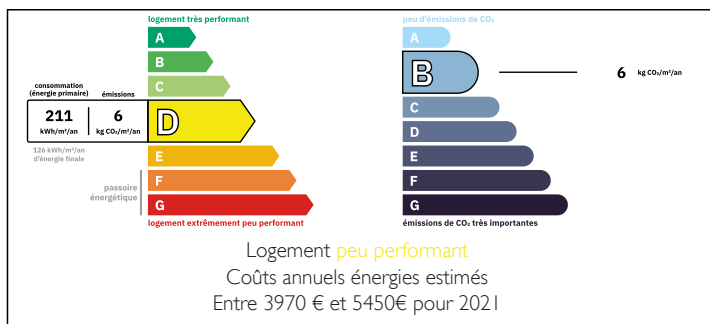

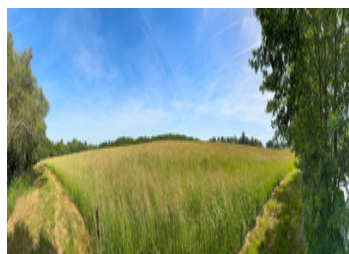

DESCRIPTION

The land comprises around 22 hectares of meadows and 6 hectares of woodland. The meadows are currently leased to a neighbouring farmer, generating modest income while keeping the land well maintained, with flexibility to regain full use if desired. The property also benefits from natural water access for a potager, fruit trees, and rights of way (footpath), all in a peaceful rural environment.

The estate comprises two spacious, communicating stone houses, offering an ideal combination of family living and ready-to-use guest accommodation. The main house features generous and welcoming living spaces, including an entrance hall, a large fully equipped kitchen (43 m²) with contemporary fittings, central island, dining area, gas hob and pellet stove, as well as a conservatory. The first floor offers an impressive 50 m² living room with wood burner, while the upper floor includes two bedrooms (25 m² and 15 m²), a bathroom and landing.

The guest wing is perfectly suited for a B&B, gîte, retreat business or multi-generational living. It includes a kitchen/dining room (20 m²), a spacious living/games room (46 m²), four large bedrooms (39 m², 30 m², 26 m² and 14 m²) and three en-suite bathrooms, providing comfortable and independent guest accommodation.

The property combines authentic character with modern comfort, including heating via wood and pellet stoves, air-to-air heat pump and electric radiators. The septic tank conforms to current standards.

The farm infrastructure includes two large stone barns, cattle housing and extensive storage areas, suitable for livestock, horses, or conversion into additional...
