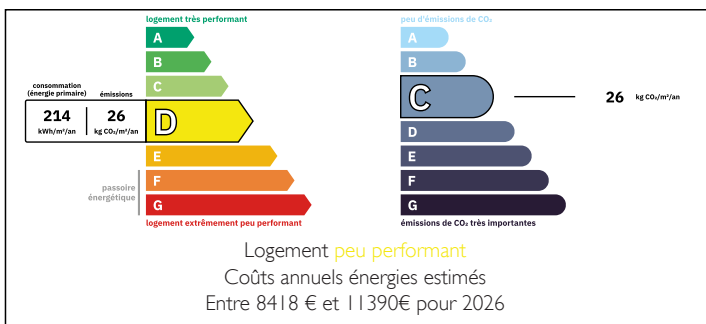
IN BRIEF

The main house (452m²) is centred around an extraordinary reception room of impressive proportions. Bathed in natural light, this spectacular space features soaring ceilings, exposed beams, a mezzanine gallery and a magnificent open atmosphere that immediately captivates. A large 25m² kitchen adjoins the living area, while the ground floor also includes a bathroom and separate WC.

The mezzanine level overlooks the reception room and provides an attractive leisure area with a billiards room and bar. Three further bedrooms, a bathroom and separate WC complete this floor.

The second house (291m²) offers comfortable independent accommodation. It comprises an open-plan kitchen, living and dining area, storeroom, large cellar, bathroom and WC. Upstairs are two bedrooms, a further WC and a vast 65m² loft space which could easily be converted into additional bedrooms or living accommodation.

Both houses benefit from large, fully functioning fireplaces, adding warmth and character throughout.

Outside, the estate continues to impress. The grounds include two lakes, mature trees, open pasture and beautiful countryside views. A substantial detached workshop provides excellent storage and workspace, while the land is perfectly suited for horses and other animals. The current owner enjoys the property alongside his dog and 10 goats, demonstrating the versatility of the estate.
