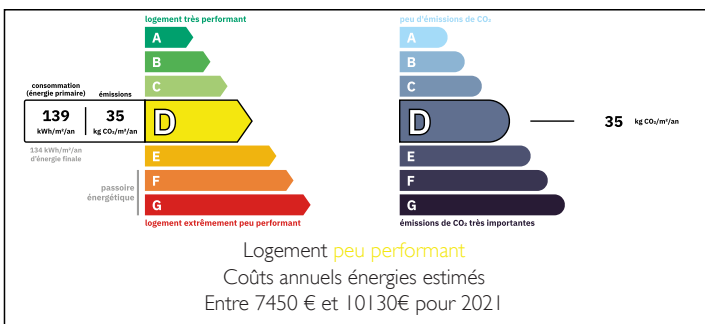

IN BRIEF

A truly stunning 5 bedroom, 4 bathroom manor house on almost 7 hectares of land, with separate 3 bedroom fully independent gite, walled vegetable and fruit garden, and beautifully manicured gardens. There is also a large barn, garage, and outbuildings including former kennel, gardeners cottage and lavoir. The manor house comprises lovely fitted kitchen, elegant hallway with sweeping staircase, utility room, living room, dining room, library, office, 5 bedrooms (4 ensuite) and open plan mezzanine areas. There is an amazing vaulted double cellar. The lovely gite has a hallway, open plan living and kitchen area on the ground floor, and on the first floor it has 3 bedrooms and a fitted bathroom. The house was renovated in 2004 and the gite in 2024. From the grounds the owners can enjoy stunning views over the surrounding countryside. The outside area also...

DESCRIPTION

The main entrance to the front of the manor house leads into a truly breathtaking large hallway (47m²) with a feature sweeping staircase. A door to the right of the hallway leads into the kitchen (19m²) with fitted units, gas cooker, dishwasher, fridge freezer, electric oven, microwave and gas Faber heater. There is an external door from the kitchen into the gardens at the side of the house. Stairs from the kitchen lead down into the vaulted double cellar with historic doors, whilst to the other side of the kitchen a small staircase leads up to the impressive dining room (30m²) with large windows to two sides giving a bright and airy feel. All the rooms have beautiful high ceilings and original parquet floors. To the left of the hallway is a utility room (14m²) with points for washing machine, dryer, freezer, and the gas heating boiler. There is also an additional access point to the cellars.

Up on the higher level of the ground floor, next to the dining room is a large living room (39m²), with large windows giving expansive views over the grounds, and to the left of this room is the library (15m²) and an office (30m²).

There are two original 19th century chimneys in working order.

On the first floor there are two beautifully appointed bedrooms (24m² and 18m²) with ensuite bathrooms, a lovely mezzanine sitting area and two large storage cupboards. The larger bedroom has a functioning chimney.
