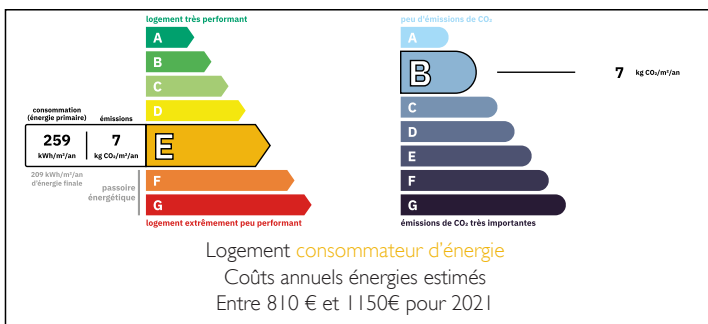
IN BRIEF

DESCRIPTION

There are houses you visit, and houses you feel. This one belongs to the second category — a place where the River Vienne becomes part of your daily rhythm, where mornings begin with birdsong rising from the valley and evenings melt into soft light over the water.

From the road, the house appears modest, almost shy. But step through the half-glazed door and it opens like a secret: a welcoming sitting room with a new wood-burner glowing in its chimney piece, and a door that draws you straight out toward the terrace and the sky. A few steps down, the kitchen unfolds — warm, convivial, with its dining area framed by glazed doors that capture the river like a living painting. Here, meals are shared with the seasons as your backdrop.

Upstairs, the bedrooms nestle under the eaves, full of charm and gentle angles. The master bedroom offers a view so intimate and serene that waking up feels like a privilege — the river stretching out below, mist rising, light shifting hour by hour. The second bedroom, with its tucked-away spaces and quiet corners, invites creativity: a study, a reading nook, a retreat for guests or family.

Below, the lower ground floor whispers of possibilities. Once an independent apartment, it could easily become one again — a haven for visitors, a private studio, or simply a place to dream up new projects.
