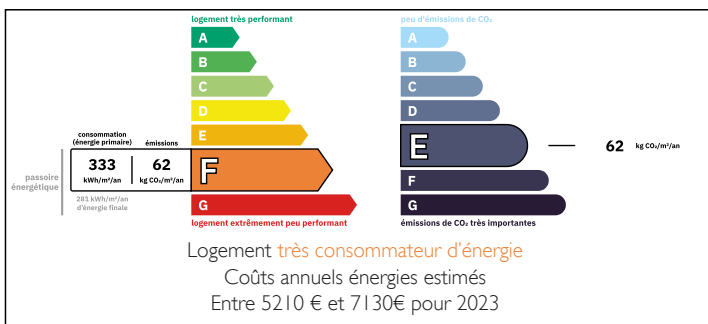

Recent improvements include a completely new roof (2021), replacement shutters (2023), insulation upgrades and new double glazed patio doors leading directly to the garden and terrace.

Original beams, wooden floors and period features preserve the character and charm of this authentic country home.
