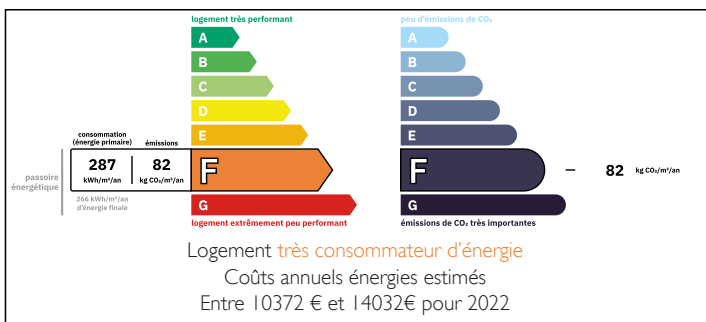

IN BRIEF

Dating from the 16th century, this magnificent former cloister occupies a prime position in the heart of Champigny sur Veude. Rich in architectural heritage, the property showcases exceptional period features, including a sculpted 17th century stone staircase, impressive fireplaces, tomette tiles and exposed beam s. The interiors offer generous, beautifully proportioned spaces ideal for both refined living and effortless entertaining. Outside, an idyllic walled park extends across the grounds, enhanced by century old trees and a tranquil stream that meanders along the far edge of the garden — a rare combination of privacy, charm, and timeless character.

DESCRIPTION

Crossing the enclosed front garden, you enter into the entrance (7 m²). Ahead is a room used as a study (12 m²) with fireplace and double doors to the rear garden. To the right is the living room (28 m²) with 17th century fireplace and windows to both the front and rear gardens. Back in the hall, off a corridor (6 m²) is the dining room (25 m²) with a fireplace, fitted cupboard and window and door to the rear garden. A door from the dining room opens to a hall (7 m²) with door to the rear garden. Continuing through is the fitted and equipped kitchen (29 m²) with cosy dining space and 16th century feature fireplace. A door leads on to the conservatory (31 m²) which opens to the rear south-facing garden; Double doors also lead out to the front courtyard garden. Back off the corridor is a WC (2 m²) and space with wash handbasin (1 m²). A door gives access to the garage (38 m²).

Up the 16th century stone spiral staircase to the first floor, to the left of the stairs, off a landing (1 m²) is a corridor (8 m²) with windows over the front garden. Starting at the end of the corridor, there is a walk-in closet (2 m²). The first bedroom (23 m²) has fitted cupboards and a fireplace. There is then a bathroom (14 m²) with bath, shower and sink. The second bedroom (23 m²) has...
