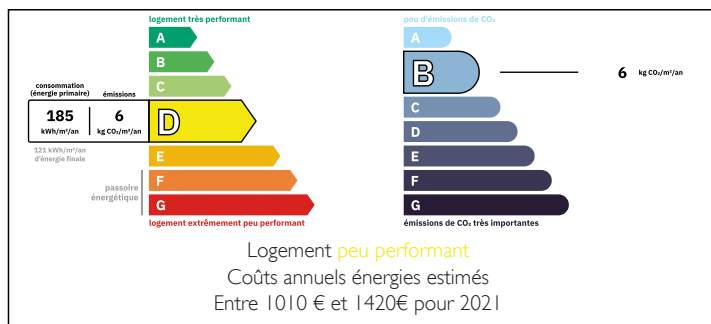
Elegant Townhouse in Brittany's Famous Book Town of Bécherel.

Set within walking distance of cafés, restaurants, artisan shops and bookshops, this is the perfect home for couples, professionals or remote workers

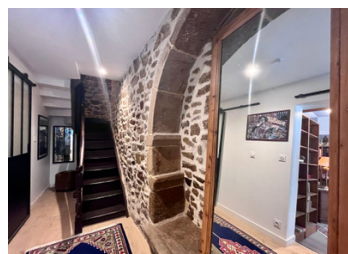
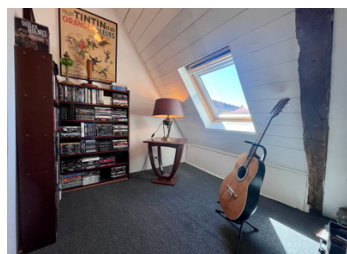
