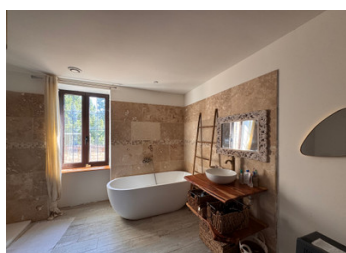

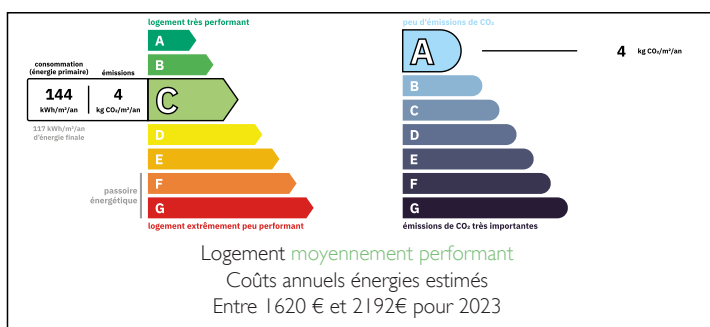
IN BRIEF

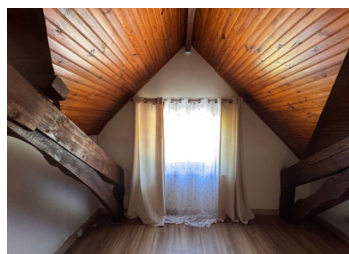
