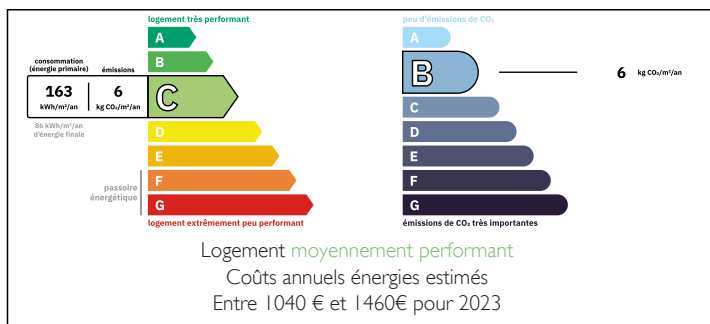


Village House with Garden & Covered Terrace – Saint-Léon-sur-Vézère

IN BRIEF
