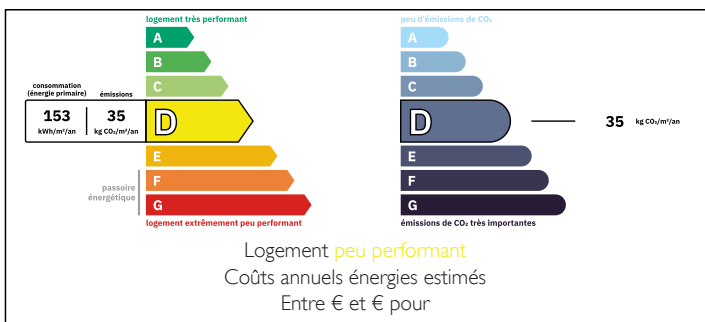

In excellent condition and ready to move into, it is ideally located within walking distance of the historic town centre, making it a perfect permanent home or lock-up-and-leave holiday property.

DESCRIPTION

This attractive and character-filled property is set below the ancient ramparts of a fortified medieval town, on the banks of the River Armançon.

Recently renovated to create additional living space while carefully preserving its original features, the property offers a rare opportunity to enjoy life in a historic setting where time seems to stand still. The town boasts a rich cultural and historical heritage, with easy access to major French and European cities.

The house is entered through a gated courtyard garden and a conservatory leading into the main living area. The ground floor features a bright, open-plan living space showcasing exposed oak beams, a timber ceiling, and a striking galleried mezzanine. A beautiful wooden staircase connects the upper floors. Throughout the house, there are lovely views of the medieval stone buildings and rooftops.

Ground floor:

Spacious living room with glazed doors opening onto the conservatory and garden.

Practical fitted kitchen with direct access to the riverside path.

Shower room with washbasin and WC.

Impressive stone fireplace and many original character features.

First floor:

Three bedrooms.

Principal bedroom with en-suite shower room and WC.

Separate WC serving the remaining two bedrooms.

Mezzanine with office area, TV lounge, and gallery library.
