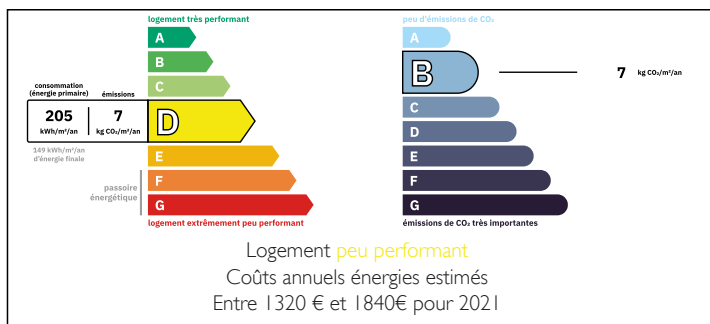

Traditional Stone House Dating from 1625 in Saint-Malon-sur-Mel, Brittany

Dating from 1625, this charming character stone house in Saint-Malon-sur-Mel offers approximately 92m² of habitable space over two floors.

Originally a commanderie, the property was completely renovated in 2017, retaining its historic character while providing modern comfort.

The house offers two bedrooms, a welcoming living room with wood-burning stove, open-plan kitchen and dining area, and a shower room.

Improvements include chestnut wood windows and doors, an air-to-water heat pump with hot water production, and underfloor heating throughout both floors.

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DESCRIPTION

Historic Stone House Dating from 1625 – Saint-Malon-sur-Mel, Brocéliande

Dating from 1625, this unusual character stone house in Saint-Malon-sur-Mel combines an interesting history and original features with the comfort of a complete renovation carried out in 2017. With approximately 92m² of habitable space, two bedrooms and approximately 600m² of land/garden across the lane, the property offers a peaceful countryside setting in the Brocéliande area.

Originally a commanderie, the building has a fascinating history. The ground floor was traditionally used to guard and store weapons, while the commander lived on the upper floor. The house retains elements of this history, including its original staircase and characterful timber finishes.

NOTES

The house was completely renovated and finished in 2017, combining its original character with modern comfort. During the renovation, all windows and doors were replaced with attractive chestnut (châtaignier) wood frames. An air-to-water heat pump with hot water production was also installed, with underfloor heating providing warmth throughout both the ground and first floors.

On the ground floor, the property offers a welcoming living room with a wood-burning stove, together with an open-plan kitchen and dining area.

An original staircase leads to the first floor, where a spacious landing is currently used as a second bedroom. This level also provides access to the shower room and a further large bedroom. The bedrooms feature attractive oak and chestnut finishes, adding warmth and character to the accommodation.

The heat-pump boiler is located on the second floor.
