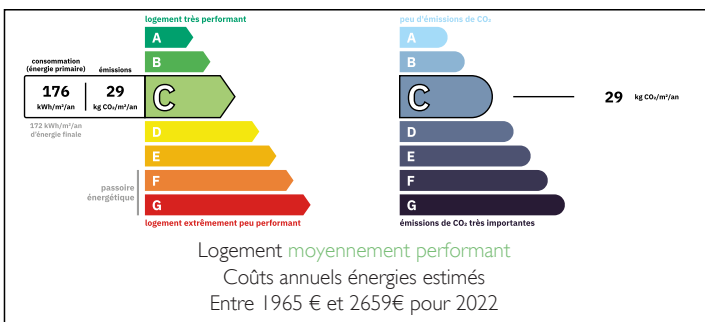

The original 1872 stone house retains its authentic character, with flagstone floors and an open fireplace, while the second, more spacious house offers independent accommodation and a generous veranda overlooking the countryside.

Together they provide around 240m² of living space and six bedrooms, ideal for extended family, guests or a home-and-gîte project. Outside, a lovely 7m x 3m pool with secure terrace sits within grounds combining open land and woodland.
