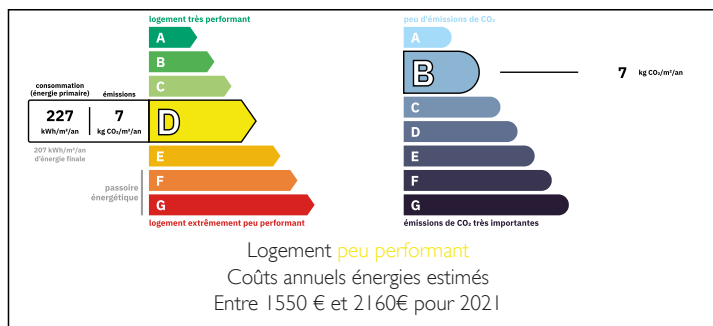

DESCRIPTION

Tucked away at the end of a private lane with no passing traffic, this wonderful countryside property enjoys an exceptionally peaceful and secluded setting, surrounded by its own land and with beautiful views across the surrounding countryside towards Lubersac in the distance.

The property combines a characterful main house with an independent furnished gîte, a substantial attached barn, further barns and hangars, and approximately 3.8 hectares of land. With mature gardens, pasture, woodland, a vegetable garden and chicken run, it offers an attractive combination of home, lifestyle and potential.

The main house is full of traditional character, with exposed beams, wooden and tiled floors and fireplaces, while benefiting from double glazing throughout.

The house opens into a bright and welcoming dining room of approximately 26.2m². This charming room has tiled flooring, exposed beams and an attractive fireplace incorporating an old bread oven, together with a wood-burning stove.

To one side is the spacious living room, measuring approximately 25.7m². With its wooden floor and exposed beams, this is a particularly inviting room, centred around a wood burner set into the chimney. Patio doors open directly onto a wooden terrace overlooking the rear garden and the surrounding countryside — an ideal spot to sit and enjoy the peaceful setting.

On the other side of the dining room is the first bedroom, currently used as an office, measuring approximately 19m² and featuring wooden flooring.

At the rear of the dining room is the kitchen, approximately 13.8m², fitted with wooden units and a wooden...
