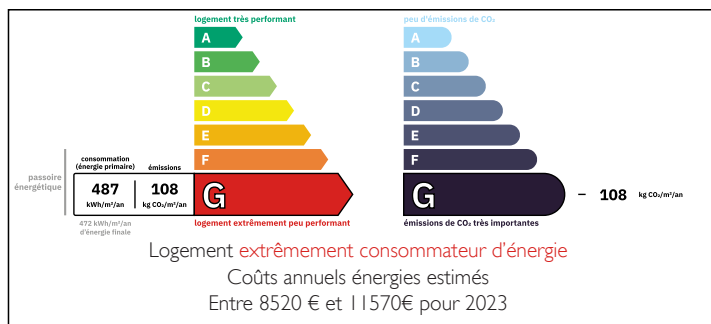

The attractive pergola here is currently used to play table-tennis. Steps lead down to a large, in-ground pool with a second pergola covering a Summer kitchen and dining / lounging area. DESCRIPTION

Entrance to the property is through gates into a large parking area. The house and buildings are set back from the entrance and built in a way that affords privacy and shelter from the elements.

The house comprises an entrance foyer (10m²) with tiled floor and exposed stone walls.

On one side, there is the sitting-room (30.7m²) with traditional wooden beams, tiled floor and a large, attractive, open fireplace. There are stairs from this room to a mezzanine bedroom (23m²). From this bedroom, there is a dressing-room (7m²) and separate WC (1.9m²). There is also a large bathroom with a corner bath and twin wash-hand basins (10m²). The barn can be accessed via an existing doorway in the dressing-room, if the development of further rooms was desired.

Also accessed via the sitting-room is a bathroom (12m²) with bath, shower, WHB, bidet and WC. From here there is a small utility room with a washing-machine and the hot water tank.

To the right-hand side- of the entrance foyer is the kitchen (14m²). This room leads into the dining / living-room (42m²) where there are two mezzanines currently used as sleeping areas for guests. This room has a woodburner and a functioning pizza oven. It has a door leading to a lovely, secluded garden and a second door leading to the front terrace. There is also a bedroom off this room (26m²).

Outside, there is a barn (91m²) with a cool-storage room (11.6m²) and a separate room for the oil...
