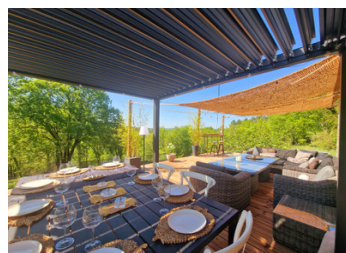
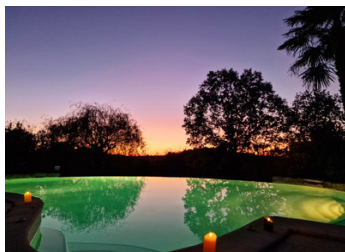

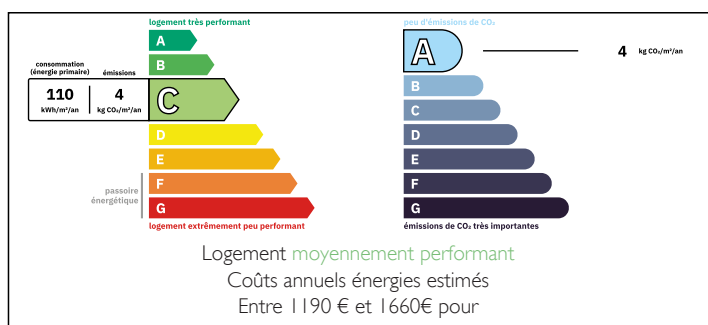

Three beautiful Quercy stone buildings, completely reimagined with an architect's eye, come together to create an extraordinary and harmonious whole. Here, the old has not been erased — it has been celebrated.
