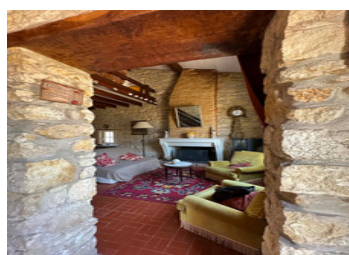


A character property steeped in history, 15 km from the ocean

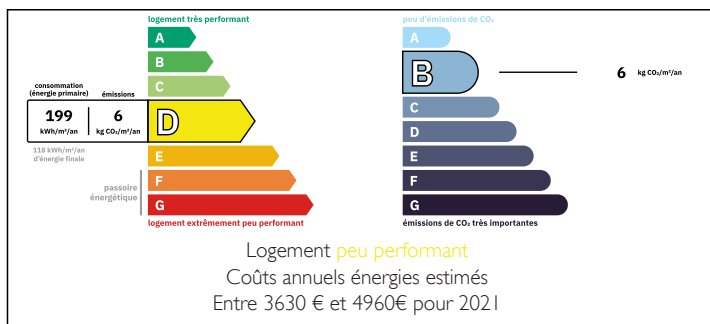
Authentic charm abounds, featuring traditional Gironde floor tiles and exposed stonework.
