Held by the same family for decades, the house has retained its old-world charm, featuring beautiful terracotta floor tiles, a fireplace, a bread oven, and exposed beams.

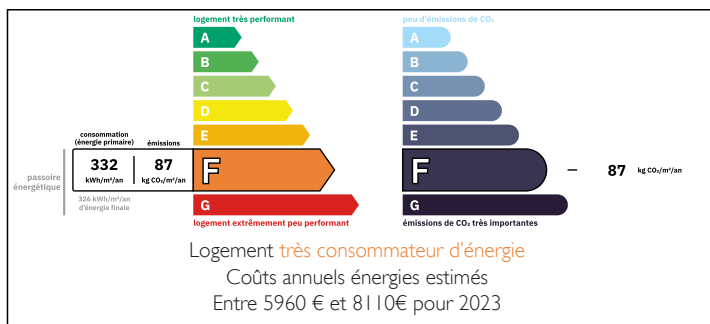

This charming longère in the Perche region comprises, on the ground floor:

- A living room with a fireplace (27 m²)
- An eat-in kitchen with a bread oven (15 m²)
- Two bedrooms with garden access (16 m² and 16 m²)
- A playroom (16 m²)
- A landing, a shower room, and 2 toilets (11 m²)

Two staircases lead to the upper floor, which features 3 comfortable bedrooms and a dormitory.

An open garage (70 m²), a cellar, a workshop, a well, and a hedge-enclosed garden with trees (1,400 m²) complete the property.
