Garden level:

two bedrooms, one with direct access to a terrace;
separate WC.

Significant energy-efficiency improvements have been carried out, resulting in an excellent DPE B rating, including a heat pump with reversible air conditioning, double glazing, a thermodynamic hot-water system and roof insulation.

This property will particularly appeal to those looking for nature, open space and a privileged living environment, while remaining within easy reach of local amenities.
