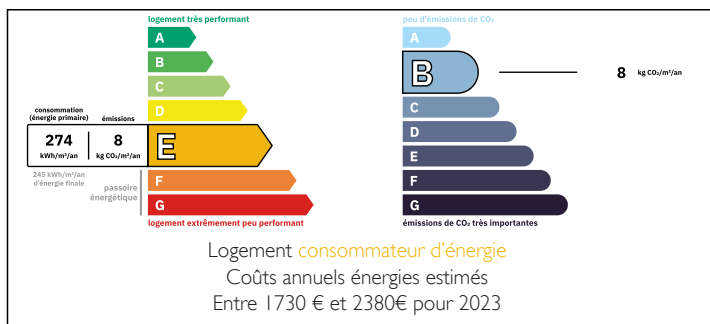

DESCRIPTION

Located on the edge of a village with lovely open views over the countryside, this charming stone house offers approximately 126 m² of living space.

On the ground floor, the entrance opens into a bright and welcoming living room, enhanced by a fireplace and wood-burning stove. The kitchen, open to a dining area of around 19 m², is fully fitted and equipped, with French doors leading directly onto a terrace—perfect for enjoying sunny days. This level also includes a practical utility room with external access, as well as a shower room with WC.

Upstairs, the landing leads to a spacious master bedroom of approximately 20 m², along with a comfortable bathroom featuring a shower, bathtub, washbasin, heated towel rail, and WC. A hallway leads to two further bright bedrooms of around 12 m² each. There is also an attic providing useful storage space.

Outside, the property benefits from attractive outbuildings, including a workshop of approximately 28 m² with a concrete floor and a barn of around 50 m², offering great potential for various uses. The enclosed and landscaped garden extends to both the front and rear of the house, set on a plot of 1,145 m², allowing you to fully enjoy the peaceful surroundings.

The house is equipped with a wood-burning stove for heating, double glazing, and non-collective (septic tank) drainage.
