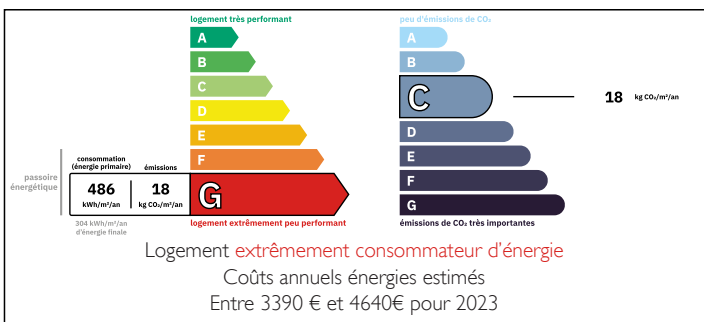
## IN BRIEF

## DESCRIPTION

The property has a particularly appealing connection between the house and its outdoor spaces, with several terraces and seating areas providing different places to enjoy the garden, dine, entertain or simply relax beneath the trees.

On the ground floor, the house offers two bedrooms and two bathrooms, one of which is ensuite. The fitted kitchen / dining room has doors opening onto a covered terrace, making it easy to step outside for morning coffee or enjoy meals in the shade.

A few steps lead up from the kitchen to the large and cosy living room, where exposed stone and a wood-burning stove create a warm and welcoming atmosphere. Doors open from the living room onto a terrace overlooking the garden, while another door provides access towards the rear of the property.

From here, wooden steps lead up to one of the property's most attractive features, a large covered veranda/balcony. With its wooden structure, stone walls and views through the mature trees and planting, this is a wonderful outdoor room and an ideal place for long lunches and evening meals in the shade.

Beyond the veranda is a versatile studio/seating area, with windows overlooking the garden. This could make an inspiring artist's studio or craft room, a peaceful home office or could potentially be converted to provide additional living accommodation.

The gardens are an important part of the property. Mature trees provide shade and privacy, while established shrubs, planting and the small vineyard give the grounds a strong sense of...
