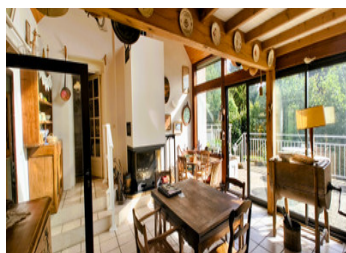


TREDUDER Characterful house with 1.55 hectares – Near the sea

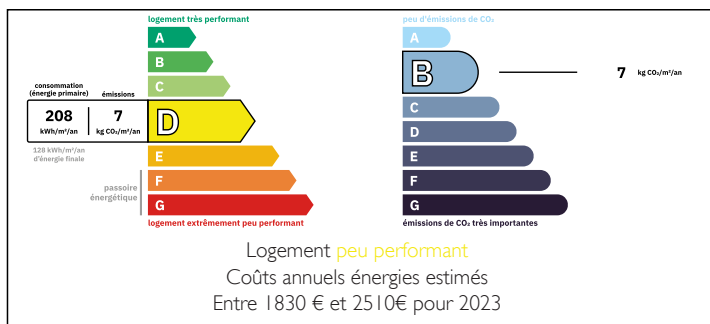
IN BRIEF

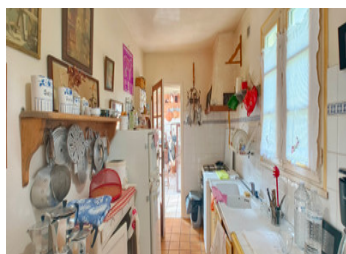
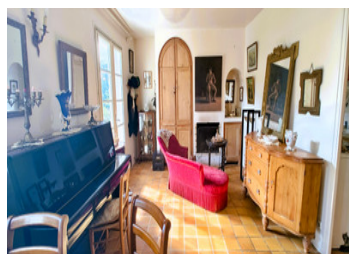

It comprises a building dating from the 1980s, an extension built in 1994, and an older stone section whose walls and tiled roof have been refurbished.

DESCRIPTION

It comprises a kitchen, a living room with a fireplace and a mezzanine, three bedrooms and a shower room. The fireplace, installed in 2021, supplements the electric heating. The wooden and aluminium windows and doors are double-glazed.

Outside, the property has approximately 1 ha 55 a 20 ca of land, comprising a meadow, a wooded area and a fenced-in area around the house. A terrace of approximately 46 m² allows you to enjoy the garden.

Several outbuildings complete the property: a garage of approximately 19 m² on a concrete slab, a barn of approximately 40 m² with a newly rebuilt roof structure and roofing, and an old building of approximately 30 m².

A shed situated in the field and a well round off the property.
