#### DESCRIPTION

The house is c. 100 m2 and offers many opportunities in terms of floorplan and design. The roof has also been maintained and there is a sky light installed so renovating upstairs would be a real possibility subject to the relevant permissions.

The current Salon is significant (54m2) and could easily be split in to two functions as it was in the past. There is also a covered porch along the front of the house.

The large stone barn, typical of the region, has endless possibilities for renovation. It's a simply a great example of the local architecture. The second barn finishes this romantic scene.

The property is set in the open countryside of the Perigord Noir.

Renovation considerations:

Water and electricity are on-site but will need updated installations.

The house roof has had relatively recent restoration work.

There is no heating and no mains drainage. A new septic tank will need to be installed.
